Needs to complete Good Clinical Practice training?

GCP training is required for all USC Principal Investigators (PIs) and Key Personnel conducting clinical trial research.

WHEN

Does training need to be completed?

Once you become part of a clinical trial, you must complete the training, which will be valid for 3 years.

If your certificate expires or is about to expire, you can complete the refresher training course to become re-certified.

WHAT

Is a passing score for Good Clinical Practice Training?

15 modules must be completed with a passing score of 80%

Is Good Clinical Practice?

Good Clinical Practice (GCP) is the internationally recognized ethical and scientific standard expected in the design, conduct, performance, monitoring, auditing, recording, analysis, and reporting of clinical trials.
